1. Courage in the Face of Trials

Through gentle humor, transparent tales of her own hard times, and a deep dive into how several Bible figures persevered through trial, Lori reveals how we all can access Christ-centered courage and confidence even in desolate places. Following each session, we will offer a short optional interaction time to process the talks:

1. **We Are Here: Psalm 42-43**
2. **Where We've Been: Psalm 107**
3. **What We Have to Say: Psalm 34**
4. **Where We're Going Now: Psalm 103**

Lori earned her Christian coaching certification through AWSA for Christian women communicators in 2020.
